STATEMENT OF PURPOSE- Childminding Setting.

AIM- To provide a safe, secure and stimulating environment. Giving the best opportunity for children to learn through outdoor play as individuals.

I will provide a service to families based in my home. I am regulated and inspected by CIW. I will care for no more than 17 children at the setting ranging from 3-12yrs (see ratios below).

Facilities available-

Premises-

We will have the use of-

- Dining room- resources are kept here, children will eat here. Parent info is kept on display
- Living room- Changing area. Sometimes used if weather really bad
- Large Outside area with access to play equipment.
- Forest space. Fully risk assessed.
- Kitchen- All safety catches/locks in place.
- 1 x toilet, upstairs toilet for back up.
- Outdoor toilet
- Outdoor heated sink.
- We mainly operate outdoors.

Ratios-

The maximum number of children for whom I look after is as follows.

ON MY OWN-

- Ten children up to 12 yrs
- Of those 10 children, no more than 6 may be under 8yrs
- Of those 6 children, no more than 3 may be under 5 yrs of age.
- Of those children no more than 2 maybe under 18mths old. Although exceptions can be made for siblings.

I will employ a full-time assistant- Carwyn James. He is Teacher qualified and has full first aid, safeguarding and Basis hygiene. We will also have a qualified level 3, third person for extra support.

Registered numbers are as follows- (With a full-time assistant)

- 17
- Of those 17 no more than 9 can be under 8yrs
- Of those 9 no more than 6 maybe under 5yrs.
- Of those 6, no more than 4 can be under 18mths

Ratios include our own children.

Services offered-

- I will provide after school 2.40-5.30pm on Monday and Wednesdays. With a pick-up from Ysgol Penrhyn Dewi. Pick up from Aidan site on Monday's and Wednesday's. Fully insured 9 seater shuttle.
- 0-3yrs- Please enquire about our full day care setting in Solva.
- We offer the 30-hour funding. 3-4 yrs only.
- Afterschool pick-up at 2.40/3pm -5/5.30 term time only. Mon and Wed only.
- Holiday club in selected holidays. 9-5/5.30pm. (Pembrokeshire Holidays dates only) We offer 2/3 days on selected holidays.

Activities Offered-

- We offer a range of outdoor activities in our large garden and forest area. These range from sports to arts and craft, games and forest activities.
- We have our very own shuttle to transport children around.
- Outdoor activities, children are encouraged to stay outside, with access to swings, a forest and large garden. We also provide a forest approach (We are a NOT forest school). We have access to our very own forest with various activities going on. We have access to visit chickens, horses and rabbits.
- We are based outside for the after-school club, with our new forest cabin., where children can play various activities. (Tennis table, Pool, Small world, arts and craft)
- Trips where possible to local parks/sites/beaches.

- Routines will be followed by all ages. Please see Routine on parent board.

Languages used-

- I will be using English as my first language. Welsh will be used. I am also happy to learn basic communication in any language to help with the settling in process.
